Presentation from Citizens' Climate Lobby: "Engaging the Political Process to Confront Climate Change"

August 18, 2018— **ROSELLE, Illinois**—The League of Women Voters of Roselle/Bloomingdale will host their annual membership kickoff at a wine tasting and fundraising event on Wednesday, September 12, 2018 from 6:00-8:00 pm at LynFred Winery located at 15 S. Roselle Road in Roselle, Illinois.

The evening will include a presentation from Steve Bogaerts, Vice Chair of the Citizens' Climate Lobby, Northwest Suburbs Chapter, a non-profit, nonpartisan, grassroots advocacy organization focused on national policies to address climate change. Steve will facilitate a discussion titled, "Engaging the Political Process to Confront Climate Change." Steve will explain why the Citizens' Climate Lobby was formed and how it confronts climate change through the political process. He will also review a currently debated national Carbon Fee and Dividend proposal which promises to reduce carbon emissions to 50% of 1990 levels within 20 years while adding jobs to the economy.
