

The 2023-2024 LWV-VA Challenge for High School Voter Registration Has Started!

The LWV-VA Challenge for High School Voter Registration began in 2016 to recognize those Virginia high schools that have established the most robust programs to register the most students!

- The 2023-2024 program will recognize every high school across the Commonwealth that meets a set of criteria established to assist a high school develop a robust program to register their students.
- Students can participate in the Challenge by using their school's unique URL found here: https://lwv-va.org/virginiahsvr/. Students without a DMV ID (driver's license, learner's permit or other ID) need to apply on paper forms. - Virginia law requires that schools must assist eligible students to register. Again, we can help you accomplish that – just email us!

What Are the Prerequisites for Registering to Vote in Virginia?

- Be a United States citizen.
- Be a resident of Virginia.
- Not be registered and plan to vote in another state.
- Be at least 18 years of age by the next general election.
 - Seventeen-year-olds who turn 18 years of age on or before the next general election (November 7, 2024) can register now.
 - Seventeen-year-olds who are registered to vote can vote in any intervening primary or special election in Virginia!
 - Sixteen-year-olds can preregister now and will automatically be registered to vote as soon as they reach the qualified age.
- Have had voting rights restored if ever convicted of a felony.
- Have had capacity restored if ever declared mentally incapacitated in a Circuit Court
