
Time to Update Our Handbook

LWV Election News


Three School Board seats are up for Election this fall along with special elections in Anoka County and Ramsey.

Filings close August 13th for Anoka-Hennepin School Board Districts 1, 2, and 5, now held by Tom Heidemann, Marci Anderson, and Nicole Hayes, respectively. District 1 includes the cities of Anoka and Ramsey. District 2 covers the east side with Northdale Middle School and Blaine High School. District 5 includes the southern end of Coon Rapids and the Anoka-Hennepin parts of Fridley, Brooklyn Park and Brooklyn Center.

LWV ABC will have a candidate forum in early October for the school board in the school board room in the Sandburg Building in downtown Anoks. We hope to include the Ramsey Ward 3 candidates, Josh Fuhreck and Dan Specht as well in this forum.

The special election to fill the Anoka County Board District 6 seat left vacant by the resignation of former commissioner Rhonda Sivarajah will be held November 5. If more than two candidates file, this will be a primary election and the special election will be held February 11, 2020. Filings close August 13th for this position. Anoka County District 6 covers Linwood Township, Columbus, Centerville, Circle Pines, Lexington and Lino Lakes, as well as precincts 17, 18 and 38 in the city of Blaine.

LWV ABC plans to have a forum in Blaine in October.


2020 Census Concerns
