ACTION REQUESTED Support Campaign Finance Reform!



IN BRIEF

Crossover is February 13. That is when the bills passed in one house of the General Assembly go over to the other house. Any bill that is not passed in at least one house will be “dead” for the 2024 session.

Delegate David Bulova’s Campaign Finance Bill seems to be stuck in the House Privileges and Elections Committee. **It must be acted upon by Feb. 9 in order to get to the floor in time.**

[HB 874](#) puts important limitations on the amount of money that can be spent on any race.

Regardless of whether your Delegate is on the Committee, contact them and urge them to ask the Privileges and Elections Committee to hear this bill tomorrow. **Let them know how important campaign finance is to you!**

Remember, you are speaking for yourself not as a member of the League.
