House and Senate Conferees are reconciling two versions of HB650

The House version is stronger and extends the proscriptions on enforcement of federal immigration laws to include, among other places, the prohibited area within 40 feet of a polling place or any place where the local electoral board is meeting to ascertain the results of an election.

The Conference Committee members are Senators Salim, Perry and McDougle. The Delegates are Callsen, Simon and Cornett.
