But some state lawmakers have rigged the rules to shift our public dollars away from our communities to the pockets of the wealthiest few and profitable corporations.

Now they want you to vote to lower the maximum state income tax rate to 3.5%. While it might sound like a promise of affordability, it won't change the income taxes you pay. Instead, it could mean fewer services and higher costs through other taxes and fees.

How will this impact me and my community?



Your communities' public schools, child care providers, food assistance, and health care services will have limited funding to serve everyone.



Your local government will have less support from the state, forcing cuts to local services — especially if you live in a rural area.



You may see higher sales tax, property taxes, and fees since costs won't disappear and lawmakers will turn to these other revenue options.

HOW WILL A PROPERTY TAX LEVY LIMIT AFFECT ME AND MY TOWN?



It can impact the quality of your public schools

Local governments are funding 6,200 teaching positions. If local leaders are forced to cut teaching positions, the quality of education for our students will suffer.



It can limit access to food and health care

Recent federal legislation is shifting more costs onto local communities for health care and food assistance. If local leaders can't raise enough funding, more families could face hunger and worsening health.



It can lead to local service cuts

Services like emergency response, public libraries, and trash collection are funded with property taxes. If this levy limit passes, local governments may be forced to cut these services.
