CLIMATE ACTION 2007



CO₂

This April 14th, tens of thousands of Americans will gather all across the country at meaningful, iconic places to call for action on climate change. We will hike, bike, climb, walk, swim, kayak, canoe, or simply sit or stand with banners of our call to action.

Event: *Together, we can slow global warming*. Part of the Step It Up 2007 campaign (www.stepitup2007.org), **Step It Up Congress – Cut Carbon 80% by 2050**.

When: Saturday, April 14, 2007; 1:00 – 2:00 pm

Location: Clemson University campus, on the Library side of the plaza between Cooper Library and the Strom Thurmond Institute.

Concept: To gather people from the Clemson area for a photo-op showing that we support action to slow the onset of global warming. The picture, taken from the roof of the Library, will show us spelling out CO₂ inside of a circle with a downward pointing arrow through it. The point of the picture is to demonstrate graphically that people of all ages (children, high school students, university students, parents, grandparents) are concerned about the future of Earth and the impact that continued CO₂ emissions will have on it.

We will send the picture and an accompanying letter to Cong. Barrett, Sen. Graham, and Sen. DeMint urging them to support legislation committing the USA to move toward an 80% reduction in CO_2 emissions by 2050. We will also give participants the opportunity to sign a petition stating that they favor legislative action to move the USA toward the reduction.
