Join the new LWVAAC History Committee! We're partnering with local organizations on two exciting, county-wide projects:

60th Anniversary of the Voting Rights Act

Arlington Public Library is creating an exhibit highlighting Northern Virginia's role in advancing voting rights — including local changemakers and League artifacts! The exhibit opens August 6 and will travel to various locations through November 4.

LWVAAC will also host a public program on September 16, focusing on the evolution of voting rights in Virginia since 1965. The event coincides with National Voter Registration Day and will emphasize the importance of voter registration.

Arlington 250th Commemoration

This initiative ties into national and state efforts to mark the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence in 2026. LWVAAC is part of a countywide planning group and will contribute to both shared and original programming.

Themes will go beyond the Revolutionary War to explore American history as an "unfinished revolution." Some funding may be available to support our projects.

We're now holding regular monthly meetings, and we're looking for passionate volunteers to join the team. We're collaborating with <u>UpVote Virginia</u> and other


