Stay Alert: Email Spoofing and Phishing Reminder

We want to remind everyone to stay vigilant when it comes to suspicious emails. Unfortunately, one of our members was recently the target of an email spoofing incident, and a misleading message was sent to many League contacts.

Please remember:

- **Double-check the sender's email address.** Spoofed emails may look like they're from someone you know, but the actual address may be off by a character or coming from a suspicious domain.
- Be cautious with unexpected requests. If an email is asking you to click a link, share personal information, or send money — especially urgently — it's a red flag.
- When in doubt, reach out directly. If you receive something odd, contact the sender through a known, trusted method to verify before taking any action.

We're working to prevent future incidents and appreciate your help in staying cyber-safe. Thank you for your vigilance and for being part of the League!
