

Drop Boxes

What are drop boxes?

Drop boxes are secure containers in which absentee ANY voter can place their ballots to be counted. You can utilize these boxes during early voting (between 45 days and the Saturday before election day) or on election day.

Where can I find one?

- During early voting, drop boxes will be available at all early voting locations, which include [your local registrar's office](#) and [satellite locations](#).
- On election day, drop boxes will be available at [your assigned polling location](#).
- Both during early voting and on election day, there may be additional locations at which your locality has placed drop boxes. You can find these locations at your [locality's website](#).

How will my vote be protected? Will I need ID?

- Voter ID is not required to place an absentee ballot in the drop box, but your Social Security Number is required to apply for an absentee ballot. Other ID may be required for absentee voting if you are a first time voter, which you can find in the absentee voting portion of this guide.
- All drop boxes will either be secured with a lock or staffed by election workers.
