#### What to Take to the Polls

Voter registration card
One of the acceptable voter IDs
List of who/what to voter for

### What Happens at the Polls

State name and address.

Show voter registration card and one of the acceptable voter IDs (If no photo ID, sign a simple form).

Sign your name on a list of voters to record that you are voting.

Vote! Your vote is secret—only you will know who will know who you voted for.

Each county has a different voting system:

- Some counties vote with a paper ballot. Just fill out and turn in.
- Many counties vote with a voting machine. To practice

  Scroll to bottom of the page, pick your county from the
  drop-down menu and click on <Go>.
