
LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS' OF THE LEWISBURG AREA

Important! To vote for candidates in a primary, you must be REGISTERED in either the Democratic or Republican party. Non-partisan voters can ONLY vote on any ballot questions.



REDISTRICTING

After the census, which is conducted every 10 years, reapportionment and redistricting are required so that 435 seats in the U.S. House of Representatives, 50 seats in the Pennsylvania (PA) Senate, and 203 seats in the PA House of Representatives are divided equally based on population changes. The map below shows the new district maps that have been drawn:



The new <u>76th Legislative District</u> (shown in light grey in the map to the left) is made up of voters who reside in:

- UNION COUNTY:
- * Boroughs of Hartleton, Lewisburg, Mifflinburg, and New Berlin
- * Townships of Buffalo, Hartley, Kelly, Lewis, Limestone, and West Buffalo
- **OTHER:** Clinton County

The new **<u>83rd Legislative District</u>** (shown in dark blue in the map to the left) is made up of voters who reside in:

- UNION COUNTY: Townships of Gregg and White Deer
- **OTHER:** parts of Lycoming County

The new <u>85th Legislative District</u> (shown in light blue in the map to the left) is made up of voters who reside in:

- UNION COUNTY: Townships of East Buffalo and Union
- **OTHER:** Snyder County & parts of Mifflin and Juniata counties

- 11 Last day for withdrawal by candidates nominated at the primary

- 20 Last day to REGISTER before the November election

VOTING INFORMATION (CONT.)

VOTING IN PENNSYLVANIA

ALL registered voters in PA now have the following voting options:

- IN PERSON: You can check your polling place at the website <u>www.vote.pa.gov</u>. If you have moved or can't remember where you vote, contact the County Elections Office to make sure you go to the right polling place. This information is also on your Voter Registration card.
- MAIL-IN BALLOT: You may apply for a mail-in ballot without an excuse. For more information, see the AN ABSENTEE OR MAIL-IN BALLOT section below.
- ABSENTEE BALLOT: You may vote an absentee ballot by mail:
- * If you will be out of your municipality during the polling-place hours on Election Day
- * If you are a student who is registered to vote at home
- * If you have an illness or physical disability that prohibits you from going to your polling place
- PERMANENT BALLOT LISTS: You may ask to be placed on a permanent absentee voter or permanent mail-in voter list.

AN ABSENTEE OR MAIL-IN BALLOT

How to Apply

- 1. Request an official <u>ballot application form</u>:
- *IN PERSON, BY MAIL OR PHONE:* At the Elections/ Voter Registration Office (see <u>"Union County</u> <u>Elections" on page 2</u>)
- ONLINE: At <u>www.vote.pa.gov</u>, in the Voting in Pa menu option, choose Mail-In and Absentee Ballot.
- 2. Return the completed <u>application form</u>. Completed civilian applications for <u>mail-in</u> or <u>absentee</u> ballots must be RECEIVED by the County Elections Office *by 5pm on the Tuesday before Election Day* (postmark does not matter).
- 3. When you receive your ballot, **VOTE!**
- 4. Return your completed <u>mail-in</u> or <u>absentee</u> ballot to the Elections/Voter Registration Office *by 8pm on Election Day*.

When to Apply

BALLOT APPLICATION DEADLINE: No later than **8pm on** the Tuesday preceding the election, except in cases of emergency. To obtain an emergency absentee ballot, contact the Elections/Voter Registration Office (see "Union County Elections" on page 2).

When to Return the Ballot

BALLOT-RETURN DEADLINE: You may return your completed civilian <u>mail-in</u> or <u>absentee</u> ballot to the Elections/Voter Registration Office *as late as 8pm on Election Day*.

What is the LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS?

The LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS was founded in 1920 after women won the right to vote; our local League of Lewisburg was founded in 1954. We strive to ensure that citizens are informed about issues and prepared to participate in community building and government. Through candidate debates, issue forums, community dialogues, and online discussions, the League helps to inform voters on issues of local, regional, and national concern. We encourage all women and men aged 16 and older to join us.

QUALIFICATIONS

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE in Pennsylvania elections, you must meet all of the following conditions:

- Be *a citizen of the United States* for at least 30 days before the election
- Be *a resident of Pennsylvania* and your election district for at least 30 days before the election
- Be *at least 18 years of age* on the day of the next election
- Be *a registered voter* (see information under **REGISTRATION** below.)

REGISTRATION

How to Register

TO REQUEST AN OFFICAL REGISTRATION FORM:

- IN PERSON: At these county locations:

- * Union County Assistance Office
- * All Post Offices
- * The Union County Public Libraries
- *ONLINE:* At <u>www.vote.pa.gov</u>, under **Register to Vote**, choose **Register to Vote Online** from the menu options.
- From the LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS, the political parties, and other organizations

A *Voter Identification Card* **confirming registration** will be mailed to you in approximately two weeks after application submission.

When to Apply

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE is *15 days before Election Day*. See the <u>"2025 Election Calendar" on</u> <u>page 2</u> to find the date of Election Day.

When to Update Your Registration

NOTIFY THE ELECTIONS/VOTER REGISTRATION OFFICE, if you:

- Move within Union County
- Change your name
- Wish to change your party affiliation
