


Interconnectivity

- Benefits
 - More Options for Travelers
 - More Opportunities for Lower Stress Routes
 - Increased Capacity of the System
- Concerns
 - People Like Their Cul-de-sac's
 - Private Street Standards
 - May Require the Use of Buildable Property

Importance of Connectivity



Interconnectivity

- DelDOT Standards
 - Requires Connectivity
 - Connectivity Index
 - Parcel Connectivity
 - Requires multi-modal facilities
 - Bike, Ped, Transit
 - Limited on Cul-de-sac Length
 - Geometric requirements

Location and Type of Development

- Provide Opportunities for Mixed Use Development
- Density Comprehensively Planned for the Right Area
- Support Other Transportation Modes
- Greater DevelopmentSetback on Major Arterials



More Walkable and Bikeable

- Support Sidewalk Requirements
- Support Sidewalk and Bike Connections
- Bike Racks






Access to Transit

- Partner to Identify New or Expanded Routes
- Identify Opportunities for Flex Routes
- Connectivity from Commercial Development to Transit
- Age Restricted Development adjacent to Fixed Routes

- Support for North South Study and Implementation of the Plan
- Support for Continued Planning and Projects for the East West Corridors
