Presidents' Message

This coming election season is rapidly approaching! Even *before* Labor Day – the traditional 'start' of the electoral season – we are experiencing a surge in volunteers and registration opportunities! This is fantastic! To that end, there will be some relevant information below about voter registration and other events!

General Voter Registration Information:

There's a number of voter registration activities – from farmers' markets to art exhibits – that we're receiving this year. We're going to be sending out regular voter registration volunteer calls throughout this election cycle.

If you're new to registering voters, a good way to get started is to select an event that already has volunteers signed up and go as an observer. This will give you an opportunity to see how it's done and get a little more comfortable with the process. You can also request to be put with an experienced volunteer. Email us at www.lingtonva@gmail.com if you would like to make arrangements for these options.

Here is the current LWVAAC voter registration sign-up sheet; you can sign up for events now and more will be added as they emerge.

We already have number of voter registration events scheduled through October. We plan to start the fall High School Voter Registration Drive in mid-September and to conduct a number events on National Voter Registration Day on 17 September. We expect to schedule these and additional events into the fall, so stay tuned for more details and get ready to `power up' for these important events. Plan ahead and sign up now for registration event(s) you like.

Additionally – and *new* this year – is the possibility of post-registration presence and messaging efforts. Our voter registration efforts traditionally end on the last day that people can register to vote or update an existing registration (15 October this year). After that, people can use Same Day Voter Registration to either vote early or vote on Election Day. We may have some opportunities to engage in public events to encourage people who might have missed the 15 October deadline that they can *still vote* in this election by using Same Day Voter Registration. We'll be monitoring this situation and send out requests for volunteers if this looks like a viable action.
