

President's Message

Get ready for Transformation! As many of you know, LWVUS is changing things up starting early next year and we will be directly impacted. There's a lot of information to convey about this so that League members understand; but your basic experience of League life will be unchanged. For some of you – along with the information provided below – that will be enough for you to know. For others, you'll want to know details of the dues structure and the tax implications (i.e., no longer can claim 100% tax deduction on dues).

Below is an overview of the changes (called Transformation), along with some numbered paragraphs that cover key pieces. There's also a sign-up to attend the training we are providing **Tuesday**, **7 January**, **7:00pm via Zoom**.

Let's get started:

Transformation is an initiative by the LWVUS to increase our numbers and our diversity by making it easier to join through one national platform. At the same time, dues will be harmonized across local leagues and administrative processes will be standardized and streamlined. Thus, the key impact for us is changing the dues and membership structure. Below links provide information from LWVUS. LWVAAC 2025 Transformation Dues Structure Meeting Sign-Up

Key elements:

1. <u>Dues Amount Change:</u> Currently, LWVAAC dues amount is established by LWVAAC at \$60.00 individually; household \$90.00 (basically, individual + half); lifetime members and students are free.

On February 1st, LWVAAC will adopt the new dues amount of \$75.00 per member, payable at your next renewal date. There will no longer be a 'household discount' or a 'household membership.' Lifetime members, who have been members for more than 50 years, will still be free. Students will pay a minimum of \$20.00 (or however much they can afford).

2. <u>No Paying Dues Via Check</u>...YET. At this time, LWVUS has not established a methodology to track your dues paid by check back to our local LWVAAC or (state) LWV-VA. We anticipate this will be resolved. If you are typically a payby-check member and you're **not** okay with switching to online pay, come to the training on 7 January.

If you've been a pay-by-check member and you are okay with switching to online, go to #3.

3. <u>ChapterSpot Account.</u> On or about first week of February 2025, every member with an individual email currently active in our system will receive an email with instructions to log into the new portal in ChapterSpot (the new membership platform). Every League member will thereby have access to their membership account in order to pay dues, make donations, update their information, etc.

4. <u>Gifts to LWVAAC and LWVUS.</u> Many of you have supported LWVAAC with \$100.00 for your annual dues with the direction that \$60.00 is for dues and \$40.00 is a gift to LWVAAC. Please know going forward that if you pay \$100.00 to LWVUS you will be paying \$75.00 for your dues and a \$25.00 gift shared between LWVUS, LWV-VA, and LWVAAC, of which only a small amount will go to the LWVAAC and be tax deductible. We anticipate a direct donation option to be available at some point whereby you can pay dues and, at the check-out screen, be able to add an additional amount directed to LWVAAC. Until we have confirmation that this mechanism is operational, we ask that all donations to LWVAAC be done separately (via PayPal) or through the mail. We'll keep you posted on developments here and update you accordingly.

High School Classroom Registration Training

Mark your calendars for <u>Saturday, 25 January 2:00 – 3:30pm</u>; Arlington Central Library (1015 N. Quincy Street, Arlington).

Last year we registered over 550 students when we went into US government and other Senior Social Studies classes to talk about the importance of voting and to register students to vote. We are working on finalizing the dates of when we will be in the classrooms but it will be most of the month of February. Similar to past years we will also do lunch time voter registration outside cafeterias on the days we are in classrooms. So we need lots of help with this effort!

LWVAAC Voter Services will conduct a training for everyone participating in

High School Classroom presentations on January 25 from 2:00-3:30pm. The classroom has been updated to focus on state offices since that is what is on the ballot next year. New and experienced volunteers are encouraged to attend.

Join us for the 2025 Legislative Roundtables! All will be hybrid - the zoom link will be the same for each roundtable.



(1) Alexandria will elect a new City Council in November; their term will start in January 2025 and go through December 2027 (three years). Alexandria's City Council is an at-large election; electing six members at the same time. This presents us with an opportunity to advocate for RCV in Alexandria. This is a fantastic opportunity for Alexandria League members to get involved in a significant long-term effort focused on Alexandria. Additionally, this effort will require a good deal of community building and networking; these are

opportunities to build long-term relationships in the Alexandria community.

(2) There is a new leadership volunteer opportunity with League of Women Voters of Virginia (LWV-VA). We need a team leader for the state Mis/Disinformation Group.
