## **Winter High School Voter Registration**

From 16 January – 2 February **forty-six** volunteers from the League of Women Voters of Arlington and Alexandria City (LWVAAC) and partner organizations **registered 520 high school students to vote**. This included 482 students from Arlington high schools and 38 from Alexandria.

For the 2023-24 school year LWVAAC has registered a total of 566 students including 528 from Arlington high schools and 38 from Alexandria.

Many thanks to Arlington Public Schools, Saint Stephens, Saint Agnes School, and all the volunteers from LWVAAC and partner organizations who worked together to make these voter registration drives such a success.


