LWVAAC Review of LWV-VA Study on Right to Vote

New information regarding the LWV-VA Right to Vote Study

The in-person meeting will take place **Sunday, November 24** (instead of November 17), at Beatley Library in Alexandria from 1 p.m. – 4 p.m. We likely will not use all that time; but we'll be able to take the time we need. The virtual meeting will take place on **Friday, November 22**, at a time that reflects the most availability on the sign-up document.

Volunteers Needed: Ranked Choice Voting - Alexandria

Alexandria will elect a new City Council in November, with their three-year term beginning in January 2025 through December 2027. Alexandria's City Council is an at-large election; electing six members at the same time. This presents us with an opportunity to advocate for Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) in Alexandria.

LWVAAC and UpVote Virginia will have an initial meeting in the next several weeks to discuss planning a way forward. For this initial meeting only LWVAAC members and UpVote members and staff will be present.
