
<u>Election Messaging</u>: This year, in addition to 'Are you registered to vote?,' we are also messaging 'Have you checked your registration?' Voters can be inadvertently deleted during episodes of voter roll maintenance. This year we're taking the extra step in Arlington and Alexandria to remind already registered voters to check their registration status. In Virginia, you can check your status here: https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation.

Additionally, if you choose to vote by mail/absentee ballot, we *strongly recommend* the use of drop boxes this year or mailing your ballot *at least* 10 days before November 5. Please encourage your neighbors and voters to do the same! Any questions? Reach out to us at lwvarlingtonva@gmail.com.
