REMEMBER: You need to complete the Virginia Department of Elections Voter Registration Training **before** you sign up to volunteer. To complete the training (about 45 minutes), click here:

<u>Election Messaging</u>: This year, in addition to 'Are you registered to vote?,' we are also messaging 'Have you checked your registration?' Voters can be inadvertently deleted during episodes of voter roll maintenance. This year we're taking the extra step in Arlington and Alexandria to remind already registered voters to check their registration status. In Virginia, you can check your status here: <a href="https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation">https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation</a>.

Additionally, if you choose to vote by mail/absentee ballot, we strongly support the use of drop boxes this year or mailing your ballot at least 10 days before November 5. We ask that you all recommend the same as you engage with your neighbors and voters. This applies to both Arlington and Alexandria. ### **LWVAAC** Review of LWV-VA Study on Right to Vote

Our League will have an opportunity to review a new state study on the right to vote.

<u>Background</u>: The LWV-VA Voting & Elections Issue Group proposed a new study addressing universal suffrage as expressed in Senator Locke's 2021 bill SJ272 which originally called for the "universal right to vote." That bill, which would have removed the felony conviction and mentally incompetent stipulations in Section 1, Article II of the Virginia Constitution, also added a "fundamental right to vote" clause to the Section 1 title and the body of the first paragraph.

<u>Update 9/18/24:</u> Apologies – the study didn't make it out until this week! In light of folks being busy with voter registration and other activities ahead of the

election, we likely will not review the study as a League until late October or November. Our input will be due in December.

The data entry volunteers' job is to type out our list of newly registered voters and enter names and addresses in order to make it easier for postcarding volunteers to address and write postcards to potential voters.

### **LWVAAC Needs Your Help!**

We've got a couple things going on that we need some help with:

- 1. More Alexandria Folks. You know what we need more of? Alexandrians! We welcomed Alexandria to our League in 2022 and we're glad we did! I want to issue a special invitation to our Alexandrians to get involved. As might be expected, given our history, LWVAAC can be rather Arlington-centric. We've got a few terrific Alexandrians that are all in and we love them for it! But we need more. Even if you're not sure exactly what you want to do, reach out to me and let me know if you're an Alexandrian that would like to be more involved. We'd like to connect you all together. We especially need help with the upcoming Candidating Forum on 6 October.
- 2. **Bylaws Change Committee**. In the first of two adhoc committee needs, we need a few folks that will work to change our LWVAAC Bylaws on officer/director terms. We would like to alter the language to result in more flexibility when terms are not fully served. For example, the officer and director terms are currently one or two years; ideally, we want that language to be written in such a way that minor changes to terms can be accommodated without having to rewrite the Bylaws. Additionally, we would like to restore a staggered term protocol that can be flexible.
- 3. <u>LWVAAC Gift Policy Committee</u>. In the second of two adhoc committee needs, we need a few folks to work out an LWVAAC gift/donation policy for LWVAAC members that covers a variety of situations (i.e., condolences, retirements, etc.).
- 4. <u>Election Integrity/Security Email Listserv</u>. We have had an Election Integrity/Security Committee for a number of years, but at this point, there is no

committee leader and some of the initial issues have coalesced and situated themselves appropriately at the state level. That said, we would like to preserve a key intent of the original group: to share election security/integrity information so that we're better informed about these things. We anticipate this era of election distrust to linger for some while and it is important to have some folks in our League committed to sharing information. Unless a leader emerges (volunteers anyone?), I propose that we use the committee in a 'listserv' capacity whereby, as folks find relevant articles and so forth, the information is shared to the whole committee. If you're interested in this – either leading it or participating in it – let me know at email below. We may have an initial kick-off type of meeting to generally discuss the framework; after that, we'd just let the listserv exist. I'm open to ideas.
