Speaker pro tempore Chuck Clemons Announces Opening of Application Period for GRU Authority

In response to the creation of the Gainesville Regional Utility Authority through the recent passage of CS/HB1645, applications are currently being accepted by the Governor's Office of Executive Appointments to fill the Authority's five Director positions. As stated in the legislation, the Authority will manage, operate, control, and have broad authority with respect to operation of Gainesville Regional Utilities. Additionally, the terms of office for each of the Authority's Directors will commence on midnight of October 1, 2023, with an initial meeting of the Authority targeted for October 4th. Applications will be accepted throughout July and August.

Among the Authority's five Directors, the law requires -

- One must be a residential customer with substantial knowledge of GRU, its operations, and its history.
- One must be the owner or representative of a private, nongovernmental customer consuming at least 10,000 kilowatt hours per month of electricity during the previous 12 months.
- Three must be competent and knowledgeable in one or more specific fields including, but not limited to, law, economics, accounting, engineering, finance, or energy.

In order to be eligible for appointment and to continue their service as a Director, each must -

- Maintain their primary residence within the electric service territory of GRU's electric utility system;
- Receive GRU electric utility system service at all times during the term of appointment;
- Have no felony conviction; and
- Be a qualified elector of the City, except that at least one member must be a resident of the unincorporated area of Alachua County or a municipality in the county other than the City of Gainesville.

For the purposes of providing steady turnover, the initial appointments will consist of staggered terms with the inaugural Authority having one member each for a one, two, and three-year term, and two members with four-year terms.

Applicants are directed to first download the blank Gubernatorial Appointments Questionnaire to their computer, to which they can then input their information and save as a pdf file. The questionnaire is available at the following link –
