

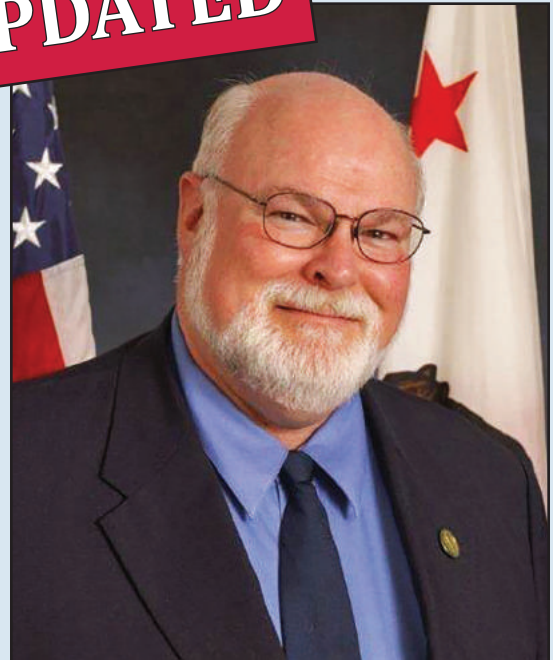

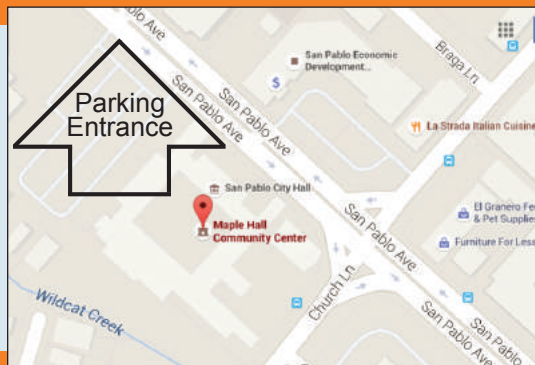
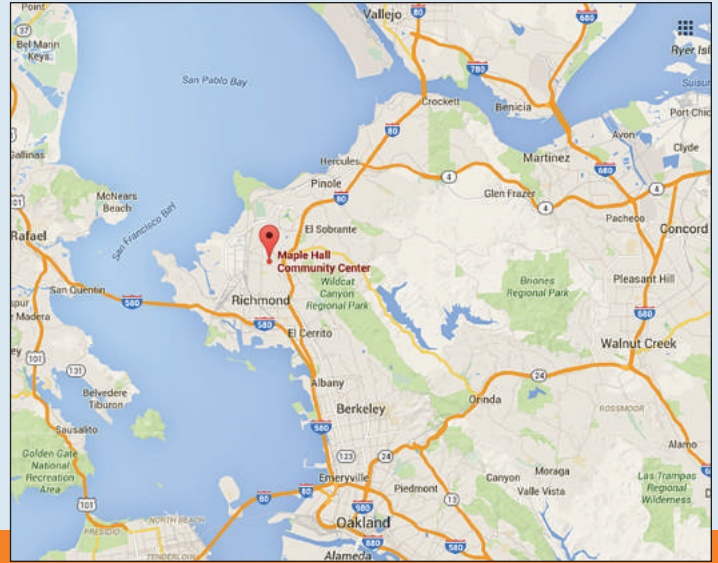

Bay Area League Day will be held inside Maple Hall, which is housed within the city hall complex for the City of San Pablo.



The City of San Pablo is nestled in northeast Richmond, west of I-80.

Maple Hall is at 13831 San Pablo Avenue at the intersection of Church Lane.



South from Vallejo on I-80: Exit 19A on El Portal Drive headed west, left on Church Lane, right on San Pablo Avenue

North from Oakland on I-80: Exit 18 on San Pablo Dam Road headed west, right on San Pablo Avenue

East from San Rafael I-580: Exit 9 on Cutting Boulevard headed east, left on 23rd Street, right on San Pablo Avenue

Free parking is available directly north of Maple Hall, entering from San Pablo Avenue (pictured above).

Additional free parking is available at the Las Montanas Supermarket (pictured at right), located just north of Maple Hall.



Maple Hall is accessible via AC Transit bus lines 72 and 72R (but not 72M). The 72 stops at 13700 San Pablo Avenue. The 72R stops at San Pablo Avenue and Van Ness Street.

BART riders can transfer to the 72 and 72R at the El Cerrito del Norte BART Station.
