Government Shutdown

An agreement has been reached and the spending bill signed into law, funding the government through January. We are relieved the government has reopened and critical services are resuming, but this record-length shut down did a lot of damage.

"Millions of Americans were deprived of their paychecks, and basic human needs hung in the balance—all while our elected leaders continued to get paid, but failed to secure long-term solutions that support working families and strengthen our democracy," <u>says LWV CEO Celina Stewart in a press release</u>.
