Attendees were asked about their desire to read this book. Everyone had compelling stories about the effects of childhood adversity in their own lives and/or lives of those in their family.

Several attendees were teachers and spoke about the difficulties of teaching traumatized children.

There was robust discussion about the importance of the information contained in Dr. Harris' book. We wondered if the issue of "shame" has hindered broad acceptance of these concepts.

All attendees were in favor of continuing the conversation. Amy Davis will contact Amelia Savinova (and perhaps Randy Lewis) about leading future discussions, and possibly forming a study group. Amy also mentioned the survey distributed by Rep. Dan Griffey which included a question about addressing the issue of mental illness; there was great interest expressed in understanding the root causes of this issue in Mason County.
