Redistricting 101 Module This module, presented by an expert in the subject, explains the relationship between the 2020 census and how census data is used by the Redistricting Commission to change the boundaries of Districts. It describes how the Redistricting Commission interprets and applies census data to meet the requirements of the Washington State Redistricting Rules. Date: May 1 8:30 to 9:30am.

Introduction & Data Lenses Modules The introduction explains the Redistricting process and emphasizes the importance of citizens having a voice in this process. The Data Lenses Module, presented by an expert in the subject, takes a much closer look at census data and redistricting through 5 different lenses of importance to Mason County and the State: Race/Ethnicity, Household Income, Tribal Affiliations, Environment, and Industrial Employment.
