## What you can do to get involved.

The most obvious and easiest way is to VOTE in every election. But beyond that and the purpose of this publication is to encourage you to make your voice heard by sharing your thoughts with your elected representatives at all levels of government.

#### Remember: They Work for You.

You can do this by contacting them by email, phone or regular mail. Individually composed emails rather than forwarded bulk messages are now considered most effective, but phone calls and regular mail are good too. Try to keep your message short and to the point. If possible include the bill number and how it would affect you or others. Be sure to give your name, address and phone number. Letters to elected officials should be addressed to "The Honorable " or "Position" plus name, i.e. "Councilmember Jane Doe". Ask for a response.

The most direct method of being heard is to talk to your representative in person. On the local level this means attending open meetings. Consult webpages for info on meeting days and times.

At the state level it is possible to schedule an appointment to speak with your representative. Candidate forums and town halls are another option. Writing letters to the editor of your local newspaper is an excellent method for expressing your views and much more effective than talking back to your television.

You are ELIGIBLE TO VOTE if you are a U.S. citizen, a legal resident of Washington State and are registered to vote.

You may REGISTER TO VOTE at the County Elections Dept., libraries, schools, manned fire stations, the DSHS office or when renewing your driver's license. You must be at least 18 years old by the date of the next election and not under the authority of the Dept. of Corrections. UPDATE YOUR REGISTRATION if you move or change your name. The form is online from the Mason County Auditor's office. Deadline for registering is 8 days prior to the election if done in person and 29 days (postmarked) for mailed applications.

the election (sooner to persons serving in the military or living overseas). They must be postmarked or hand delivered to the Auditor's office or one of the official drop boxes by the day of the election before 8 pm. If you have not received your ballot within ten days of the election, call the Mason County Auditor's office (360.427.9670 or 360.275.4255 Ext. 470).

The PRIMARY ELECTION is held in August. Washington has a "top two" system. The two candidates who receive the most votes advance to the General Election, regardless of party preference.

The GENERAL ELECTION, including state ballot issues, is held on the 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November. Federal, State, County and PUD officials are elected in even years. City and District officials (such as fire, schools, ports or hospital) are elected in odd years.

SPECIAL ELECTIONS are held in February and April for voting on construction bonds or school/fire district levies.
