ANNUAL MEETING PROCEDURES

(Determined by Bylaws)

VOTING: Voting is limited to members in good standing of the League of Women Voters of North and Central San Mateo County

QUORUM: Ten percent of members in good standing shall constitute a quorum.

ADOPTION OF BUDGET: Requires a majority vote of members present and voting.

ADOPTION OF PROGRAM: A majority vote of members present and voting is required for adoption of program proposals.

NOMINATIONS FROM THE FLOOR: Immediately following presentation of the nominating committee report, nominations may be made by any member, provided that the consent of the nominee has been obtained. To make a nomination, the member must ask for recognition by the chair by the means provided for participation in the meeting.

RULES OF THE DAY

RECOGNITION: Members will be muted by the chair. Any member participating by computer and wishing to speak will seek recognition by activating the "raised hand" icon. Upon recognition by the chair, the member will be unmuted. Members participating by phone will remain on mute unless orally seeking recognition by the chair. They will state their name and will not proceed to speak until recognized by the chair.

ADOPTION OF ORDER OF BUSINESS AND RULES OF THE DAY: Requires a majority vote. Both the Rules of the Day and the Order of Business may be amended by a majority vote before adoption. After adoption, a two-thirds (2/3) vote is required to make changes.

DEBATE: Debate shall be limited to one (1) minute for each speaker. No person may speak twice to a question until all who wish to speak have had an opportunity to do so.

CONSIDERATION OF NON-RECOMMENDED PROGRAM ITEMS: Consideration of program items not recommended by the board and noticed in the annual meeting will not be allowed at this meeting.

ADOPTION OF PROGRAM: For this meeting debate and voting on program will be limited to the proposed program sent in this notice of the meeting.

MOTIONS: All motions must be submitted in writing using the online feature. Any member participating by phone shall ensure that the secretary has correctly recorded the motion.

VOTING: When the chair seeks unanimous consent on any item of business, either a raised hand or a "No" icon shall constitute an objection and voting shall proceed by another method. Voice votes shall be taken by means of the "Yes" or "No" icons, if available. Counted votes, if ordered, shall be taken by an additional "Yes" or "No" vote using the appropriate icons. No secret ballots are in order.
