



## **REGISTER TO VOTE** **UPDATE ADDRESS OR NAME CHANGE** **VOTE BY MAIL**

### **REGISTER to VOTE // UPDATE YOUR REGISTRATION**

Step 1: Complete [Registration & Information Update Form](#) print it, add postage, and mail to your county's Board of Elections (see addresses in next box).

**OR** register/update online at Ohio Secretary of State's (SOS) website: <https://olvr.ohiosos.gov>

**Deadline:** Monday, 10/05/20 – must be received by SOS or county Board of Elections

Step 2: Confirm You Are Properly Registered

### **VOTE BY MAIL -- REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT (rather than voting in person)**

Step 1: Print [Absentee Ballot Application](#), complete it, sign, date, & mail to your county's Board of Elections:

Step 2: "Track Your Ballot" once your Absentee Ballot Application is received by your Board of Elections

**Notice:** The Board of Elections will not mail your ballot until early October.

Step 3: Your Absentee Ballot will be mailed to you. Fill it out & mail it in the envelope provided.

**Deadline:** Absentee Ballots must be postmarked on or before Monday, 11/02/20.

### **VOTE IN PERSON (rather than Voting By Mail)**

- Early In-Person Voting starts Tuesday, 10/06/20, at your county's Early Voting Center.
- Vote on Election Day, Tuesday, 11/03/20, at your polling location.
