If your school has applied for and is registered for the NYS Seal of Civic Readiness you can use this class as a perfect opportunity to coordinate these efforts with your civic readiness efforts.

If your school does not yet offer this Seal this course will still serve as an excellent citizenship class for your future contributions to society and perhaps serve as a catalyst for your school to undertake the steps necessary to offer the Seal.

WHAT IS THE NYS SEAL OF CIVIC READINESS?

The NYS Seal is a formal recognition that a student has attained a high level of proficiency in terms of civic knowledge, skills, civic mindset, and civic experiences.

The Seal of Civic Readiness distinction on a high school transcript and diploma:

1. Shows the student understanding of a commitment to participatory government, civic responsibility and civic values.

2. Demonstrates to universities, colleges, and future employees that the student has completed an action project in civics or social justice; and

3. Recognizes the value of civic engagement and scholarship
