Golden Hills Community School Lesson Plan October/November 2023

Goals

Day One, October 24

Overview of Work of the League; Introduce vocabulary interaction activities and expected outcome of writing and/or public speaking contest at culminating activity.

Political Knowledge

Understand levels of government with focus on local government structure and leaders including the duties and responsibilities of citizens to build communities: (Slide presentation: GH Lesson 1)

Students to learn what is a public policy and how good public policies impact individual day-to-day life experiences. (Slide presentation: Common Good)

Students to learn how-to practices and rules for communicating and engaging with elected and appointed officials. (Slide presentation: Critical Thinking Skills)

<u>Interaction Activity</u>: Students to learn how to find who represents them on city council and school board; decide on 2 issues, one for city council and one for school board to advocate for with guest school board and city council members.

Day Two: School Board and Common Good Policies, October 26

Students to learn how to find out government and board meeting dates, and what issues are being addressed (Agenda)

Presentations from guest speakers.

<u>Interaction Activity:</u> Students to ask questions and/or comment on selected school-board issue that impacts them using learned protocols and rules for civil engagement in public government or board meetings.

Day Three: City Council and Common Good Policies, October 31

Students learn how to access league and other tools that help citizens fulfill citizenship responsibilities; what is advocacy and why it matters.

<u>Interaction Activity</u>: Students ask questions and/or comment on selected city council issue that impacts them using practices and rules of civil engagement with elected and appointed leaders in public government or board meetings.

Students to learn all about voting and the voting process.
