Gov. DeWine recently proposed a state budget that cuts school funding for public schools and raises funding for charter schools and private school vouchers. Public schools would lose over \$103 million over the next 2 years, while up to \$500 million could be spent for private or charter

schools, even though 90% of children in Ohio attend public school.

Let's Kill It at Trivia on March 27




