The Ohio Senate is still reviewing the budget <u>HB 96</u>). Read this 1-page summary which lists the horrific impact on public schools and communities.


JUST ANNOUNCED: Rally at the Ohio StatehouseWednesday, May 28, noon, for a powerful day of advocacy to demand fair funding for rural schools across Ohio. See your email from LWV Ohio sent 5/21.

The current budget underfunds schools by \$2.75 Billion. Timeline:

- Senate reviewing the bill weeks of May 19th and 26th
- Revised (sub) Bill in Full Senate Finance Committee
- Public testimony expected
- Expected omnibus amendments: June 6
- Followed by passing committee and floor vote no later than week of June 9th
- Conference Committee mid June June 25
- Need concurrence in both Chambers by June 25
- Governor needs to sign it by June 30

It is imperative that we all contact the 16 Senatorson the Finance Committee to reinstate the Fair School Funding Plan in the budget. Please contact them in a separate email or complete the form on their website. <a href="https://www.ohiosenate.gov/committees/finance">https://www.ohiosenate.gov/committees/finance</a>, Or call them.

As for federal legislation, the US House of Representatives passed the anti-voter SAVE Act on April 10. The SAVE Act still needs to be reviewed by the Senate. Click here to Contact your Senators to use a form to voice your opposition. Better yet, call Sen. Husted (202 224-3353) or Sen. Moreno (216 522-7272) directly and say vote NO.
