Advocacy Corner

We are introducing a new feature to our newsletter, Advocacy Corner. Can you spare a few minutes and use your voice to let our U.S. and Ohio legislators know where you stand on pending legislation? This document, called Advocacy Deep Dive makes it easy. It lists the bills LWV Ohio is watching and the action you can take. It includes short explanations of the bill, including why we support or oppose it. It also includes links to the bill itself and links to the senators' or representatives' contact page to quickly and easily voice your opinion. Please take a look at the subjects you care most about (education, voting rights, taxation, etc.) and choose one (or more) to call or email.

Let's Get the John Lewis Voting Rights Act Passed!

It will only take 1 minute to do your part to help get this Voting bill passed.

Simply click HERE and send your senator an email.

Every day, the freedom to vote is under attack. Since the 2012 Supreme Court decision in Shelby County, at least 29 states have passed 94 laws that make it

harder to vote, with the burden falling mostly on voters of color. We need to



fully restore VRA to defend our democracy and protect the freedom to vote. That is why LWV is proud to support the reintroduction of HR14 and S4, the John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act, which is vital legislation that is needed to fully restore and modernize the VRA and ensure that discriminatory voting policies are stopped in their tracks.





Let's Count Every Single Signature!
