



### **Citizens Not Politicians Amendment to Appear on Ballot**

Ohio's Secretary of State, Frank LaRose, announced on July 23rd that the Citizens Not Politicians amendment has been certified to be on the November 5 ballot. Hundreds of boxes were delivered to the statehouse a few weeks ago containing 731,306 signatures. During the certification process 535,005 were deemed valid, for an impressive overall validity rate of 73.2%. Also, the 5% certification rate in 58 counties was also reached. This is a tremendous accomplishment for LWV, Fair Districts and many other groups that contributed to this huge effort.

What's next: The Ballot Board must convene by August 22 or 23 to propose ballot language and give the amendment an issue number. A spokesperson from Fair Districts said "It's thrilling to know all our hard work paid off...but there is still lots of work ahead. Approximately one in ten Ohio voters signed our petition—but we want ten out of ten to vote YES. That means a whole lot of education and voter contact between now and election day, November 5.

# Next Book for LWVH Book Club Is Your Choice










### LWV Hudson Book Club August 15, 7pm Kathy Battaglia's Home
