FANTASTIC NEWS! On Monday Citizens Not Politicians delivered 731,306 signatures to Frank LaRose, Ohio's Secretary of State, to get the amendment on the ballot Nov. 5, 2024. Speaking of Ohio's Secretary of State, Frank LaRose, did you know he plans to remove more than 150,000 Ohio voters from the statewide voter registration database? This means they would be purged from voter rolls and be unable to vote. Ohio is literally spending money to bar voters from voting! Read the <u>Ohio Capitols Journal's article</u>.

There is no time when organizing, educating and registering voters has been this important. Fortunately, that is what LWV does best. Please consider joining the postcard writing party on August 1st. 

Let's Get the John Lewis Voting Rights Act Passed!




It will only take 1 minute to do your part to help get this Voting bill passed. Simply click <u>HERE</u> and send your senator an email.

Every day, the freedom to vote is under attack. Since the 2012 Supreme Court decision in Shelby County, at least 29 states have passed 94 laws that make it harder to vote, with the burden falling mostly on voters of color. We need to

fully restore VRA to defend our democracy and protect the freedom to vote. That is why LWV is proud to support the reintroduction of HR14 and S4, the John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act, which is vital legislation that is needed to fully restore and modernize the VRA and ensure that discriminatory voting policies are stopped in their tracks.
