successfully created a platform where important issues are made understandable, building confidence in women to raise their voices and be heard.

Originally from Northeast Ohio, Ashley attended Walsh and earned a degree in political science and Information Technology. She temporarily put her political science knowledge aside and focused on the IT side.
