

Early Voting: What You Need to Know



New Yorkers can now vote up to 9 days in advance of Election Day!

Dates

Early voting will begin 10 days before Election Day, run for 9 consecutive days, and end on the Sunday before Election Day.

- ▶ For the **2019 General Election**, early voting will begin on Saturday, October 26 and end on Sunday, November 3.
- ▶ You can also vote on Election Day (Tuesday, November 5) instead.

Hours

Poll sites will offer morning, evening and weekend hours for early voting. On Election Day, polls will be open from 6 AM to 9 PM.

Early Voting Locations

- ▶ You will be assigned to one early voting poll site in the borough where you live.
- ▶ You can find your assigned early voting poll site at nyc.pollsitereg.com.
- ▶ Your early voting poll site is different from your Election Day poll site.
- ▶ You can vote on an early voting day, or on Election Day at your usual assigned poll site.
