From the 405 Northbound:

Exit on Jeffrey, Turn LEFT on Jeffrey at the end of the offramp. Jeffrey becomes University at Michelson. Continue on Jeffrey/University until almost at Culver Drive The last light before Culver is at Goldenglow; at that point start

watching for the church's large free-standing cross on your right. The entrance to the church parking lot is on your right just after you pass the cross.



From the 405 Southbound:

Exit on Culver. RIGHT on Culver to University - the church, which is well-marked, will be on your left at the intersection. Make a U-turn on Culver to the church's driveway and turn RIGHT into the parking lot.

Alternate approach from the 405 Southbound - this avoids having to make a U-Turn on Culver at University.: Exit on Jeffrey, Turn RIGHT on Jeffrey at the end of the offramp. Continue as for 405 Northbound above.

Note on Leaving the Church: Both exits from the parking lot require a right turn. One exit is directly onto Culver. Take Culver to the 405; there are both northbound and southbound entrances to the 405 from Culver. The other exit puts you on University.
