## Informational Items presented by elected officials, staff and/or administrators:

There will be a lot of participation in the Woodridge anniversary parade.

Ms. Naisbitt has dropped off informational flyers with apartment managers in an effort to reach new residents. The managers have been very cooperative and posted flyers in the elevators. The Patch and the Library's newsletter, Library Leaves, keep people informed of the library's programs. Cardholders also get library e-news. Ms. Staszak said that there were people living near her who were in an unincorporated area and wanted to know if they were able to use any library services. While they cannot check out materials, they can attend library programs and use the computers at the library. There are about 1700 people with Woodridge addresses who actually live in unincorporated areas. Patti will get a list from the Village. The library's interest income, mainly from IMET, is very good. The budget was discussed and approved. Money from Tax Incremental Fund (TIF) district has increased by \$12,554. Total levy is \$3,847, 414. Total budget is \$4,078,283. There is more for digital materials in the budget than last year. For complete information on the budget, see:

The tax levy resolution was discussed and approved. This includes general funds, which are unrestricted and restricted funds, such as FICA. Resolution regarding transfer of funds from general to building site funds was approved. There was not previously enough money in the site funds for anticipated roof repairs. Ms. Dubé prefers to be conservative about the amount of money to be transferred as once it is in the building site fund, it is restricted only to that purpose. Purchase of desktop computers was approved. Current equipment is from 2011 or earlier and not in good condition. They can use Computer View Incorporated (CVI), a current service provid4r, for this as expenses under \$25,000 do not have to go out for bid. This cost is \$19, 508. Health insurance proposal was approved last month, but because some dates needed to be amended, the board needed to re-approve the proposal with the amended dates. They did so,
