Registration Deadlines

As of June 30, 2019, the deadline for registering or transferring your voter registration will be eight days before an election. If you have a valid Washington State driver's license or ID, you can go to myvote.wa.gov to register online. By mail, your application must be postmarked eight days before an election.

If you are not already registered to vote in Washington State and you miss the 8-day deadline, you can register in person at your county elections department up until 8 pm on Election Day. For more information, go to vote.wa.gov or call 1-800-448-4881.

Registration Requirements

You must complete a voter registration form if you are registering for the first time in Washington or if you have moved to a new county. If you have moved within the same county, you must change your address by completing a new form or contacting your County Auditor on-line, by mail, or phone.

To register to vote in Washington State, you must be

- A citizen of the United States
- A legal resident of Washington State
- At least 18 years old by election day

You may not register to vote if you

- Are in jail, prison or in community custody under Department of Corrections (DOC) authority
- Have been declared by a court to be mentally incompetent and ineligible to vote

Voting by Mail

All 39 Washington counties vote by mail. You will automatically receive a ballot for each election. You must inform your County Auditor if you change your residence or mailing address.

Ballots must be post-marked on or before Election Day. You may also return your ballot to the County Auditor's office or another ballot drop site designated by your County Auditor by 8:00 PM on Election Day.
