Each year, League volunteers help students and new citizens register to vote. We also send voter reminders with election information.

We gather information on candidates and ballot issues for the Voters Guide printed by the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* and available online at Vote411.org. The site allows voters to see the races on their ballots, compare candidates' positions side-by-side, read an unbiased summary of ballot initiatives and save a sample ballot.



The League supported Amendment 1 (Clean Missouri) on the November 2018 ballot that passed with 62 percent of the statewide vote. The League opposes legislative attempts to undo these reforms.

The League is working with pro-voter coalitions on 2020 ballot initiatives as part of its Making Democracy Work initiative. We support election reforms such as no-excuse absentee voting and the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact.

Our members are collecting signatures for Medicaid expansion in Missouri and working to educate residents about the importance of being counted in Census 2020.

There are four key elections in 2020: March 10 Presidential Preference Primary, April 7 Municipal Elections, August 4, Primary and November 3 General Election.
