

## VOTING BY MAIL CHANGES IN FLORIDA

## ALL REGISTERED VOTERS IN FLORIDA WHO WISH TO VOTE BY MAIL CAN REQUEST A MAIL BALLOT.

Florida law now requires that voters submit a vote-by-mail request for every general election cycle.

Previous vote-by-mail requests expired after the November 2022 general election. Voters who wish to vote-by-mail must now submit a request to their county's elections office to receive their mail ballot for all elections in 2023 and 2024.

To submit a request, voters must provide one of the following:

- A Florida driver's license
- A Florida identification card number, or
- The last four digits of their social security number.

While voters may submit a vote-by-mail request at any time during each two year general election cycle, those wishing to receive a ballot in the mail for a given election must submit their request no later than 10 days prior to election day.



Voters with disabilities who wish to request an accessible vote-by-mail ballot must submit requests for **BOTH** a mail-in ballot **AND** an accessible ballot.

After the November 2024 elections, vote-bymail requests will expire and voters must submit a new request for the following election cycle.
