Letter From the President

Happy June LWWH!

As you know, unfortunately, the Climate Roundtable was postponed until September. There were many contributing factors for the Climate Committee to make this agonizing decision.

First, the Council decision/discussion regarding Green House Gas Emission Inventory was not



resolved at their May meeting. This discussion will be taken up again by Council on June 20th. This created a serious void of information for the Workshop.

Second, it's summer and there are a lot of people on vacation. Staffing was a challenge as were concerns about attendance.

Adding to the attendance concern, the City's Comprehensive Plan Workshop was scheduled the night before on June 7th. It's asking a lot of people to attend both meetings back-to-back.

In addition to these issues, one of our key speakers, Casey Weinstein, was called away for his military responsibilities. Casey was scheduled to be a dual speaker with Chris Foster, an elected city official and local sustainable farmer. Mr. Foster recently became an active candidate running for another term on city council. Providing a platform for an active candidate without offering equal time to other candidates is in violation of LWWH's nonpartisanship policy. And that, as they say was the match in the powder barrel, the icing on the cake, the nail in the coffin, and the end of the road for the June 8th Climate Roundtable.

Garden Tour!). We will have volunteers at a registration table and also walking around town talking with citizens about Issue 1, the August 8th Election and Ohio's new voting laws.

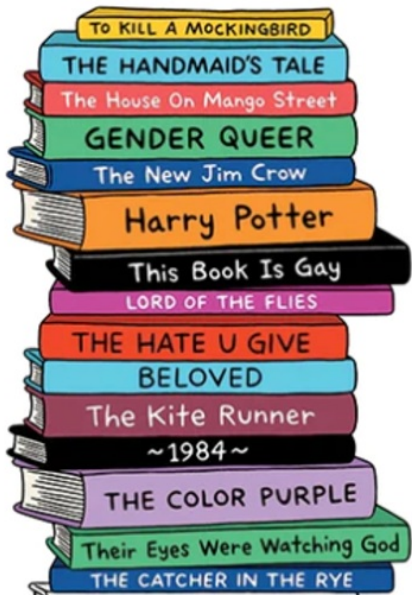
