David A. Dulio is Distinguished Professor of Political Science Department and Director of the Center for Civic Engagement at Oakland University. Professor Dulio has published eleven books, with two of his most recent being Michigan Government, Politics and Policy and Campaigns from the Ground Up. He has written dozens articles and book chapters on subjects ranging from the role of professional consultants in U.S. elections to campaign finance. Professor Dulio is also a former American Political Science Congressional Fellow on Capitol Hill where he worked in the U.S. House of Representatives Republican Conference for former US Rep. J.C. Watts, Jr. (R-OK).


## (3) LWVMI Environmental Network group: Thursday, June 15th at 11a via zoom
