**May 9** Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot. Must be received in Doylestown by 5 P.M.

**May 16** Last day for County Board of Elections to receive voted mail-in and civilian absentee ballots. Must be received in Doylestown by 8 P.M.

**May 16 MUNICIPAL PRIMARY**  
7 A.M. to 8 P.M.

**May 17** Registration resumes.

**May 23** Last day for Board of Elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots (submitted for delivery no later than 11:59 P.M. on May 15).

**October 23** Last day to register before the general election.

**October 31** Last day to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot. Must be received in Doylestown by 5 P.M.

**November 7** Last day for County Board of Elections to receive voted mail-in and civilian absentee ballots.

**November 7 GENERAL ELECTION**  
7 A.M. to 8 P.M.

**November 8** Registration resumes.

**November 14** Last day for Board of Elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots (submitted for delivery no later than 11:59 P.M. on November 7).
