Application Deadline: Tuesday, October 29 by 5pm

Town Clerk's Office

Your ballot must reach your local election office or drop box by close of polls on Election Day (November 5) in order to be counted. The only exception is for ballots returned by mail in the biennial state election in November, when 3 extra days are allowed for ballots postmarked by Election Day to arrive in the mail. Use our [Track My Ballot tool](#) to check the status of your ballot. The tracker will show you the date your ballot was mailed, the date it was returned, and whether your ballot was accepted or rejected. ~from the Secretary of the Commonwealth
