


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
Current Age in 2015


## **The Local Economy**

**Over the past 10 years employment in:** 

- + Manufacturing down a fraction of a percent
- + Warehousing and distribution down 10 percent
- +Knowledge-based sectors up 6.3 percent (pre Toyota move)
- + Health care up 65 percent
- + Total employment down 0.1 percent

Manufacturing Employment and Output (2001 = 100), Los Angeles and Orange Counties, 2001 to 2016




## **Labor Force Access**
