1. The Minutes of May 9, 2022 meeting were approved.

#### 2. Library Director's Report

- Summer Reading program will be launched on Saturday June 11: the theme is
  <u>Oceans of Possibilities</u> schools have been notified so they can promote the
  Program to their students before summer vacation. Children, teens and adults
  are all invited to sign up for the program and receive a reading log to record time
  spent reading or listening books during the summer, and a packet of fun items.
  All participants will also be able to receive a ticket for the Summer Reading Prize
  Basket Raffle. All Summer Reading Prize Raffle Baskets are sponsored by the
  Friends of Abbot Public Library.
- The Library has 2 new staff members: one adult service librarian and a teen librarian.
- The Library has now 14 full time employees and 9 part time employees.

The preparations for the move are underway: sorting out books, doing inventory of furniture objects and artifacts, selecting a moving company, etc.

The website continues to be updated and transformed and should be completed by the end of July.

The number of things to borrow keeps expanding: hotspots, a sewing machine and a graphic calculator are among the new items.

The Library is planning to organize a Fix It Clinic at the Library in the next months.

The Trustees voted in approval of the Code of Conduct and Policies of the Library

## 3. Chairman's Report

The Board's goal for the next year is to remain focused on the transitional Library and prioritizing the type of programs that will be offered during the transition. A new Board will start in July. Nancy Arata and EuRim Chun both have finished their terms will be replaced by two new Trustees. Nancy will become a member of the Building and Renovation Committee. Gary Amberik, APL Trustee, will act as Interim Chair.
