### Act Early - Vote Safely

September 30, 2020

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

We are approximately six weeks away from the 2020 General Election and the Clallam's Elections Team would like to share important information with you. Ballots will be mailed to all registered voters on October 14. That's 20 days before Election Day.

Need to Register? Update your address? Check on the status of your ballot? Many of your Election questions can be answered by logging into your Online Voter Registration Portal at [www.votewa.gov](http://www.votewa.gov) or by going to [www.clallam.net/elections](http://www.clallam.net/elections).

Anyone that cannot independently vote their paper ballot may use an Accessible Voting Unit (AVU) with large print, color contrast, and audio ballots. This unit is available in the Auditor's Office during normal business hours.

Your ballot must be postmarked or placed in a Ballot Drop Box by 8 p.m. on Election Day, November 3, to be counted. If you are using the mail, the USPS recommends voters return their ballot a week before Election Day. Voters returning their ballots less than a week before Election Day are encouraged to use an official ballot drop box.
