## **Program Notes**

#### **Proposed Rules**

Each speaker shall state their name, indicate intention, and speak no longer than three minutes. No one shall speak twice to a question until everyone desiring to speak has had an opportunity to do so.

#### **Required Votes**

Adoption of the budget and program requires a majority vote of those present.

#### Quorum

Five (5) percent of the membership shall constitute a quorum at the Annual Meeting.

#### **Proposed Budget**

The Board is proposing the following dues increase: \$75 per individual, \$110 per household, a scholarship program low income individuals who may volunteer hours in lieu of dues, and \$0 for fulltime students.

#### Adoption of Local Program

League program shall consist of those issues chosen for emphasis and action. The national League has called on local Leagues to emphasize the 'Make Democracy Work' program which focuses on four issues: Voting Rights, Improving Elections, Campaign Finance/Money in Politics, and Redistricting.

In addition, the local program will consist of local issues as recommended at the Program Planning meeting on Feb 2, 2020. Items not recommended by the Board may be proposed for consideration by members at the Annual Meeting. If a non-recommended item is offered for consideration, it is presented to the membership for decision along with the Board recommended program.
