Passage of the proposition on June 13 would provide funding for:

- Waterline replacement
  - Nearly half of Norman's lines exceeded their lifespans and are failing.
- Disinfection System
  - DEQ compliance for groundwater treatment to ensure a safe water supply.
- Lead & Copper Line Mandates
  - New, unfunded federal rules effective in 2024.
- Water Service Operations
  - Increase in chemicals, utilities & equipment costs.
